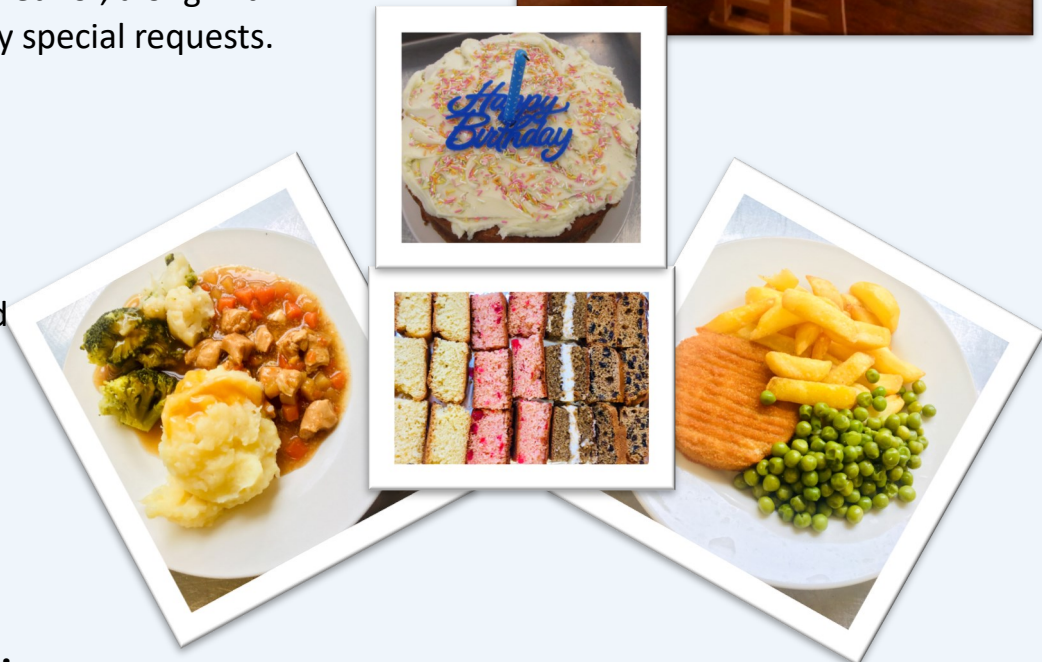


Fresh Home-Style Food:

Our catering team maintains the highest standards of traditional home cooking. We have been awarded a 5 star hygiene rating by the local Council and provide a choice of meals and tempting snacks around the clock.

Residents are given a menu to choose from every day and all dietary requirements are catered for, along with individual preferences and any special requests.

Meals can be served in the dining room, any of our lounges or in a residents own room if preferred. There are also tea trolleys that go round to all the rooms during the day, evening and night, that offer fresh drinks, snacks and some lovely homemade cakes.



Person Centred Care:

Before any admission, our Manager, Deputy or Clinical Lead would perform an assessment, either over the phone or preferably in person, to learn more about the person and to ascertain their current care needs and health status. A person-centred care plan is created and is bespoke for each resident which outlines the level of care and support they require. Our care plans include important information about our residents such as; care routines, medical requirements, emergency contact information and even certain preferences like wake-up times, favourite meals, hobbies etc...

We strongly believe that our residents have the right to be treated as individuals. All individual needs are catered for and each resident is encouraged to retain their own independence, their personal dignity and life choices. Social, emotional, religious, cultural, political, and sexual orientations are all accepted and respected.

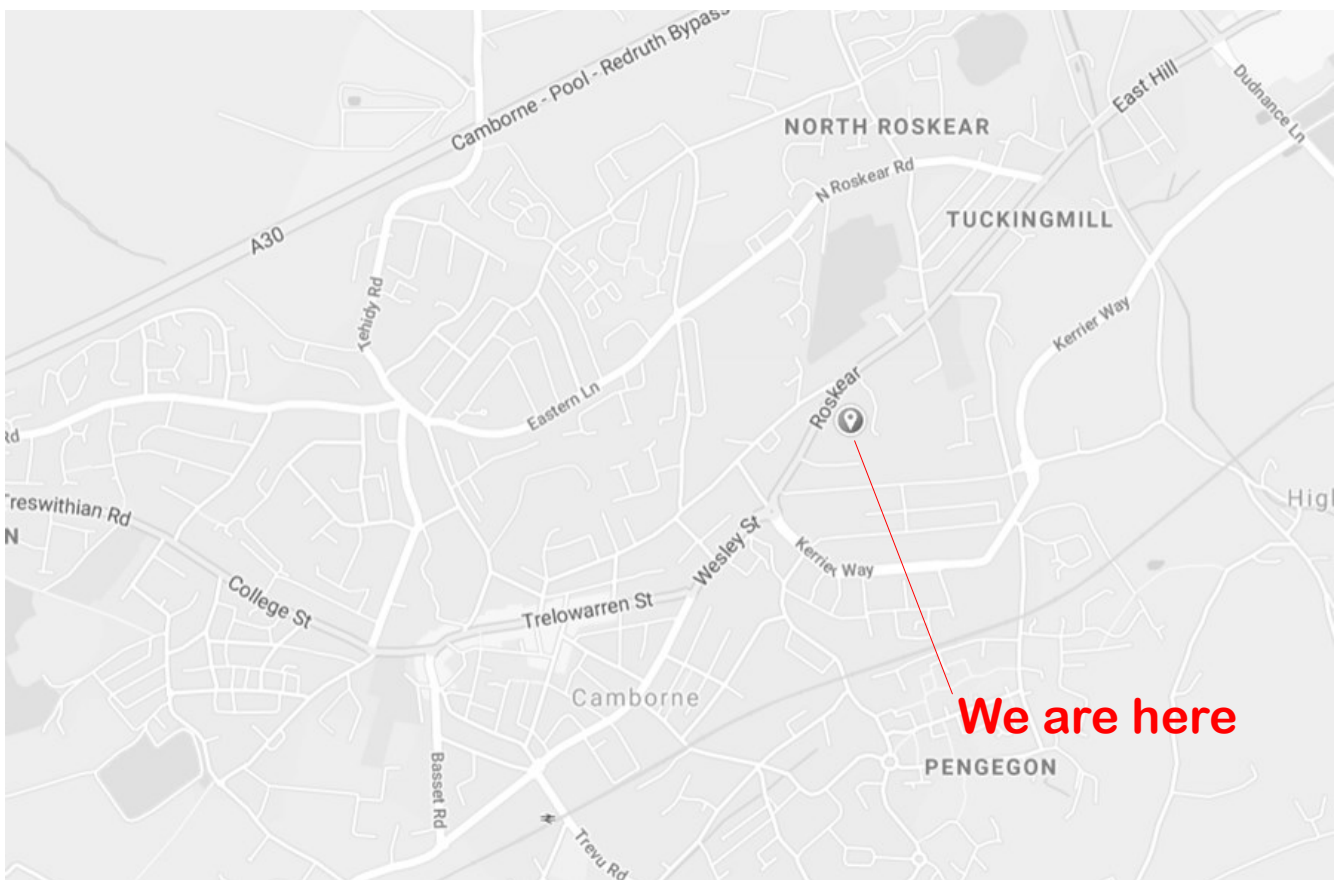
